Chris' largest focus has been Results' Functional Capacity Evaluation program, both in performance and education, ensuring a quality product across Results Physiotherapy's organization as a whole. He has furthered his clinical knowledge by pursuing and obtaining his Certified Orthopedic Manual Therapy certification (COMT), Certified Dry Needling Therapist certification (CDNT), Certified Ergonomic Assessment Specialist (CEAS) certification, and Board Certification through the American Physical Therapy Association as an Orthopedic Clinical Specialist (OCS). Chris managed and maintained a clinical case load for 10 years prior to stepping out of clinic to further focus on FCE training/mentoring, development of Results Physiotherapy's Ancillary Services (Post Offer Employment Testing and Early Intervention Programs), and management of Results' clinical quality and education (related to Worker's Compensation and Occupational Health).
